Whereas, the City of Minneapolis is generally authorized to accept donations of real and personal property pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 465.03 et seq. for the benefit of its citizens and is specifically authorized to accept gifts; and

Whereas, the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization has offered to commission new artistic fencing and foul line poles by James Brenner to match the existing backstop at Jackson Square Park, and to contribute this public art to the city; and
